Are you interested in helping reduce hazardous waste generation in Pierce County? Then you might consider getting your teeth cleaned at Dr. Broughton’s dental office. Dr. Broughton’s commitment to environmental excellence has been recognized with a “five-star” rating from the EnviroStars Cooperative.

Dr. Broughton and his staff properly manage hazardous and infectious waste and follow best management practices. Waste such as fixer from x-ray development, filters from office equipment, and lead foils are collected and properly disposed by a certified vendor. The office has also installed an amalgam treatment separator. By filtering mercury from water as it leaves the building, amalgam separators are instrumental in environmental protection. The office conserves water by turning it off at night, and even implemented a solid waste recycling program.



By going above and beyond regulations, Dr. Broughton and his staff are helping protect their patients, the community and our environment.

Dr. Broughton’s commitment to environmental health extends beyond the confines of his office. Through his activities in the Pierce County Dental Society and membership in the Washington State Dental Association he raises environmental issues for consideration and engages in continuing education on waste management issues.
